Summary

The Asian Waterbird Census (AWC) is a citizen science initiative which is a part of the global International Waterbird Census (IWC) that documents the state of waterbirds and their habitat in order to aid in their conservation and management. It is jointly coordinated by the Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS) and Wetlands International South Asia in India. It fosters participation of local conservation enthusiasts in monitoring waterbird abundance and diversity and wetland condition.

In order to institutionalise waterbird monitoring in wetlands across the country and beyond the sites designated as protected areas, the AWC network partnered with the National Biodiversity Authority (NBA) since 2022. The AWC network at the national and state-level collaborated with the State Biodiversity Boards (SBBs), Union Territory Councils (UTBCs) and *panchayat*-level Biodiversity Management Committees (BMC) to promote participation of their members in wetland conservation and waterbird monitoring, and use the census to strengthen People Biodiversity Registers (PBRs) as mandated under section 41(1) of National Biodiversity Act (2002).

Under the guidance of AWC coordinators (Annexure 4) and officials of the SBB and the UTBC (Annexure 5), more than 1,800 volunteers (Annexure 6) participated in the annual waterbird counts covering 606 wetlands from 25 States and Union Territories (Annexure 1). Twenty-two Ramsar sites were covered during the AWC 2023 census. The annual census involved the participation of BMC members from Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Odisha, Manipur, Telangana, and Tripura. A total of 214 waterbird and wetland-dependent bird species, with a total count of 35,93,953 were reported during the census (Annexure 2). The census also reported 33 IUCN Red Listed species (The IUCN Red List of Threatened Species, 2023) and fifteen high priority species enlisted under the Central Asian Flyway National Action Plan (CAF NAP) 2018-23, such as Black-bellied Tern, Common Pochard, Indian Skimmer and Lesser Adjutant, underlining its significance as an important biodiversity and habitat monitoring tool. The AWC also reports the condition of 447 wetlands, wherein habitat type and threats to wetlands and waterbirds are presented.

The census data supports conservation activities in the country by identifying significant wetlands, designating Ramsar Sites and Flyway Network Sites, and contributing to the National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan. It aids in including priority wetlands in national and state programs, national status assessments like the State of India's Birds report, and promoting community ownership in wetlands management and Important Bird and Biodiversity Areas (IBAs) globally. Additionally, the data supports species and wetland conservation, monitoring plans, and studies on bird movements and avian diseases.



1. Introduction to the Asian Waterbird Census

Waterbirds are an important component of wetland biota. Wetlands provide a biologically productive and diverse ecosystems, suitable to serve as essential breeding, feeding and resting grounds for a diverse range of resident and migratory waterbirds. Several factors govern the relationship between wetlands and waterbirds, the key being inundation regime and quality of water; availability of food and shelter; and the presence or absence of predators. Importantly waterbirds serve as bio-indicators of the ecological productivity of wetlands.

Conservation of waterbirds and their habitats needs to be based on quality data and long term as well as recent information on their distribution and trends. To effectively address this need, the Asian Waterbird Census (AWC) has been collating and disseminating information on waterbird counts and wetlands since 1987 to inform governments, conventions, and the public. The AWC runs in parallel with other waterbird censuses carried out in Africa, Europe, Central, and West Asia, the Caribbean, and Central and Southern America under the broad umbrella of the International Waterbird Census (IWC). The IWC is coordinated internationally by Wetlands International (except in the Caribbean and Central America) and is considered as one of the largest and longest-running internationally coordinated citizen-science biodiversity monitoring programmes in the world (<https://iwc.wetlands.org/index.php/aboutiwc>).

The primary objectives of IWC are:

- Monitoring changes in waterbird numbers and distribution by regular, standardized counts of representative wetlands.
- Providing the basis for estimates and trends of waterbird populations (e.g., Bamford et al., 2006 and Mundkur & Langendoen, 2022 within the East Asian – Australasian Flyway and the global estimates in the Waterbird Populations Portal (www.wpp.wetlands.org) managed by Wetlands International).
- Improving knowledge of lesser-known waterbird species and wetland sites.
- Increasing awareness of the importance of waterbirds and their wetland habitats at local, national, and international levels.

In India, AWC is jointly coordinated by the Bombay Natural History Society (BNHS) and Wetlands International South Asia, supported by state level coordinators on voluntary basis. The census is planned and carried out by these AWC India State level Coordinators and their field level volunteers. Data collected by the AWC contributes to planning and execution of conservation activities within the country such as identification of wetlands of conservation significance, designation as Ramsar Sites (under the Convention on Wetlands) and Flyway Network Sites (under the West/Central Asian Flyway Site Network of the Convention on Migratory Species), development of the National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan, inclusion of priority wetlands within National and State level programmes, feeding into national status assessments such as the State of India's Birds (<https://stateofindiasbirds.in/>) and promoting community ownership in wetlands management and Important Bird and Biodiversity Areas (IBAs) developed globally by BirdLife International. In addition, it supports species and wetland conservation and monitoring plans and studies on bird movements and relationships to avian diseases.

The summary report for AWC 2022 census, provides an analysis of waterbird counts undertaken between November 2022 to February 2023 from the aforementioned 25 States and Union Territories.

The annual AWC India count information is also summarised in longer term reports such as the AWC India 10 year report and is included in the rolling five year global summary reports on the IWC Portal (<https://iwc.wetlands.org/index.php/nattotals> and <https://iwc.wetlands.org/index.php/spectotals>) and through the AWC Site Network (<https://iwc.wetlands.org/index.php/awcsites>).

2. Asian Waterbird Census 2023

2.1 Methods

The Asian Waterbird Census 2023 commenced with the formal announcement of the census date, releasing AWC data collection forms and guidance protocols for standardised data collection on the webpage of Wetlands International South Asia, BNHS and Bird Count India in November 2022. The nationwide census was conducted from December 2022 to February 2023, with active participation from AWC State Coordinators and bird enthusiasts, SBB and UTBC officials and BMC members. The AWC 2023 data was received from the AWC State Coordinators, officials of the State Forest Department and Biodiversity Board, and eBird platform during April to July 2023 for analysis and reporting purposes ([IWC-Guidance-on-waterbird-monitoring-methodology-2018-1.pdf](#) [\(wetlands.org\)](#)).

Additional census information from a few states is yet to be received. These additional details will be integrated into the final analysis and uploaded on the IWC Portal.

2.2 Results

2.2.1 Waterbirds reported and Wetlands covered

A total of 214 (Two hundred and fourteen) waterbird and wetland-dependent species were reported during the survey period. Additionally, 152 waterbird species were documented during the census (Annexure 3). Thirty-three species were listed under IUCN Red List (v. 2023). Some of the threatened species reported were such as Black-bellied Tern (Endangered), Indian Skimmer (Endangered), Common Pochard (Vulnerable), and Lesser Adjutant (Vulnerable) and a few under Near Threatened category were Black-necked Stork, Curlew Sandpiper, and Ferruginous Duck. These records reiterate the significance of these surveys for waterbird conservation. The total count for the waterbird and wetland dependent species reported by the volunteers during the AWC 2023 was 35,93,953 (Figure 2). During the field surveys, several terrestrial bird species were recorded and a few sites reported an over estimation of waterbird numbers of a few species, such records that have not been verified by the site coordinator have been omitted while computing results for this report.




Figure 1 Number of sites reported in the AWC 2023

Monitoring during the AWC 2023 was reported for 606 wetlands covers 25 four states and union territories (Figure 1 and Map 1). Out of the 606 wetlands included in the report, many lie within the network of national Protected Areas (PAs) and IBAs. A total of twenty-one wetlands designated as Ramsar sites (Map 2) were reported in the census. The highest number of wetlands surveyed was from Kerala, accounting for 116 wetlands, while only a single wetland was surveyed each for the states, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, and Manipur (as per the reported data).






Figure 2 State-wise number of waterbirds reported in the AWC 2023

2.2.2 Waterbird species abundance

The 2023 census reveals that the **Common Coot** was most abundant followed by the **Northern Pintail, Gadwall, Common Coot, Mallard, and Eurasian Wigeon**, all species listed as of Least Concern (LC) on the IUCN Red List. The list of the five most abundant waterbird species and the number of wetlands from which they have been reported is displayed in Figure 3.

Out of the 214 waterbird and wetland dependent species that were recorded, five were listed as Endangered, eight as Vulnerable, and twenty as Near-Threatened (Figure 4 and Map 3).





Figure 5 Number of High Priority migratory Species (CAF NAP 2018-23) reported in wetlands during the AWC 2023

2.2.3 Wetland assessment




Figure 6 Wetland extent coverage during the AWC 2023

Of the 606 wetlands covered during the AWC 2023, wetland assessments were carried out and reported for 447 wetlands. Of these 296 wetlands are inland/freshwater habitats, whereas the habitat type for 196 wetlands was coastal/saltwater. Based on the wetland coverage during the census, the data was categorised into Complete (100%), Excellent (75-99%), Good (50-75%), Moderate (25-50%), Limited (< 25%), and Partial (not quantified) (Figure 6).




Figure 7 Duration of census reported during the AWC 2023

Of the sites where the census duration was recorded, 45% of wetlands were covered in less than thirty minutes, followed by 39% with a census spanning between thirty and sixty minutes, and 16% with a census spanning more than sixty minutes (Figure 7).

The census observed multiple threats to wetlands and were categorised into ten categories, pollution due to domestic sewage, solid waste, and pesticides, were the most frequently reported problem (Figure 8 and Image 1). Domestic sewage introduces excessive nutrients and pathogens, leading to eutrophication and degraded water quality, which harm aquatic life and waterbirds. Solid waste, including plastics and other non-biodegradable materials, accumulates in wetlands, causing physical hazards to wildlife and releasing toxic substances as it breaks down. Pesticides from agricultural runoff contaminate water, affecting the health of plants and animals and disrupting ecological balances. These pollutants collectively degrade the ecological integrity of wetlands, impacting biodiversity, water purification functions, and the livelihoods of communities relying on these ecosystems. The agricultural runoff contaminate water and bioaccumulate in the food chain, leading to poisoning, reproductive issues, and population declines in waterbirds. These combined threats significantly disrupt the health, survival, and biodiversity of waterbird species in wetland ecosystems.

2.2.4 Participation

More than **1,800** volunteers across 25 States and Union Territories viz., Andamans and Nicobar Islands, Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Ladakh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Mizoram, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, and West Bengal participated in the census (Image 2). The highest number of participants that volunteered in the census were from Kerala (**670 in 116 sites**), followed by Maharashtra (**278 in 72 sites**) and Gujarat (**246 in 96 sites**). Some of the sites recorded their maiden AWC census, such as Gobind Sagar Lake, Himachal Pradesh. The AWC was widely reported in the local media in many states (Image 2). The AWC 2023 observed municipal participation from the SBB/UTBC and their BMC members, Forest and Wildlife departments, habitat corporation, local NGOs, universities, and bird enthusiasts (Image 3). The census data collected was compiled and reviewed by the AWC India State Coordinators and officials of SBBs/UTBCs. The collated state level data was communicated to the AWC India national coordinators for final review and analysis.

The annual Asian waterbird census at the Coringa Wildlife Sanctuary, from Vakkolapudi beach in Kakinada to B.R. Ambedkar Konaseem Wildlife Sanctuary will be conducted on Tuesday.

Around 70 people, including local volunteers, will take part in the survey. The department will take part in the survey along with the collaboration with the Wildlife Institute of India (WII) and the National Institute of Wetlands (NIW).

Members from the Wildlife Institute of India, Zoological Survey of India and NGO birdwatchers of Andhra Pradesh will take part in the survey. Officials said that 12 teams have been constituted, with each team having a bird expert, a person to record sightings, a photographer and a local guide. The areas will be covered on foot and by boats, but the extent will depend on the weather conditions. An orientation programme will be held at the spot in winter and in the inaugurating session, Forest Range Officer Varpasani Rao said that this will be the 12th edition of the census, which helps in conserving the biodiversity of the region.

Kakinada divisional forest officer I V.K. Raju said that the sanctuaries were a migration hot spot in winter and that the census will help understand patterns of bird migration.

DNHS deputy director P. Sankaranarayanan said that the objectives of the waterbird census were to monitor the population trend.

3. Opportunities and Challenges

The citizen led AWC fosters participation of diverse stakeholder groups in monitoring and conservation of waterbirds and their habitats. It provides an opportunity to BMC members and other concerned citizens to strengthen People Biodiversity Registers with systematic information on wetlands and waterbirds, and documenting traditional knowledge associated with their conservation and wise-use. Additionally, encouraging local communities and BMC members to become active in wetland Integrated Management Planning.

The information generated through the annual AWC can be used in numerous ways such as determine both short-term and long-term population abundance and richness trends, assisting in the evaluation of wetland condition and its maintenance, promote their sustainable management through wise-use, and encouraging nature-sensitive activities. This joint effort between AWC India, NBA, and State Forest and Wildlife Departments highlighted that such initiatives can help in raising awareness on waterbirds and their conservation issues, wetland positive behaviour, convergence among various conservation policies and programmes, such as the National Plan for Conservation of Aquatic Eco-systems, Amrit Dharohar Initiative, Central Asian Flyway National Action Plan - India, Biodiversity Heritage Sites, Other Effective Area-Based Conservation Measures (OECM), Important Bird and Biodiversity Areas (IBAs), and many others. Although the surveys are primarily focused on assessing waterbird diversity and abundance, the methodology involved often goes beyond the margins of conventional habitat monitoring, delving into the details of the significant aspects of wetland functioning. This involves evaluation of wetland condition through assessment of key features such as water quality, habitat integrity, habitat use, etc. which helps to monitor wetland health status. As a result, it becomes easier to recognise risks to wetland ecosystems, which serve as waterbirds' principal habitat, and to implement management measures to mitigate those threats.

In spite of multi-faceted opportunities and benefits associated with the annual census programme directed primarily at the conservation of wetlands and waterbird habitats, it encounters a number of challenges in its implementation. Primarily, inexperience in waterbirds identification, difference in bird nomenclature, and improper data reporting leads to inferior and disorganised reports. Nonetheless, by means of frequent field visits and capacity-building initiatives, the AWC coordinators and BMC members could overcome this challenge. It is also difficult to determine the current trend of the waterbird population because wetland locations are not consistently covered. Another challenge is the infrequency of complete or reported wetland assessments of count sites, which leaves a gap in the information needed to evaluate the health status of wetland habitat and current and potential threats to birds and their habitats.

4. Way Forward

Strengthening the AWC and improving the overall census activity in India, the following measures can be taken:

1. Implementation:

- a) Expanding the network of AWC coordinators throughout the country, ensuring each state and union territory has a coordinator, and if required, engage regional assistant coordinators for better implementation of the census.

- b) Developing the capacity of coordinators through yearly training sessions and encouraging interaction amongst coordinators to share experiences and expertise regarding planning for the implementation of the census, data collection, and reporting.
 - c) Since AWC is a citizen science programme, involving the appropriate line department can help to foster a sense of ownership and ensure regular census and reporting. For example, the state wetland authority, forest department, research organisations, avifaunal experts, local communities, and others can be engaged.
 - d) Comprehending the population trends of waterbird species at the regional and national levels, ensuring that sites that have already been assessed under AWC are surveyed every year.
- 2. Data collection and analysis:**
- a) Improving database management through standardised data collection methods for efficient data collation, data analysis, and reporting which align with the IWC data interface.
 - b) Ensuring that data reporting is completed within the allotted time frame for effective data collation and analysis.
- 3. Communication:**
- a) Identifying AWC champions in each village panchayat and BMC in consultation with SBB/UTBC and AWC state coordinator. AWC reports, state media coverage, etc. can feature the stories of the AWC champions, wetland mitras, and coordinators who made outstanding contributions to the census as a way to show gratitude and inspire others.
 - b) Expanding the reach of AWC network by incorporating local communities, institutions, schools, etc. for being a part of the census and raising awareness regarding the same.
 - c) Sharing database with other relevant citizen science groups and initiatives.
- 4. Management and monitoring:**
- a) Improving the monitoring and management of waterbird species and their habitats, it is important to identify the habitats of waterbirds that are located inside the protected area network and perform yearly and seasonal censuses. In addition, incorporate the necessary management activities for waterbird conservation and management into all protected area management plans.
 - b) Devising participatory conservation action plans for priority wetlands and species.
 - c) Incorporation of AWC results into regional People's Biodiversity Register so as to create an extensive database of various aspects of biodiversity.
